New trafficking Bill to be complemented by changes in IPC, says Irani

DURING A National Consultation meet ahead of the tabling of the Trafficking in Persons (Prevention, Care and Rehabilitation) Bill, 2021 in the monsoon session of Parliament, Union Minister for Women and Child Development Smriti Irani on Friday said that the Ministry of Home Affairs has agreed to bring changes in the Indian Penal Code in keeping with the new Bill.

She said the Bill not only provides for protection of victims, but also protection of witnesses of human trafficking crimes.

"In many a conversation it has been highlighted that the IPC does not conform to, or live up to, the expectation of the populace with regard to stringent punishment when it comes to human trafficking. I'm happy to share that in our conversation with the MHA, we have been assured that appropriate amendments to the IPC will also be made to complement the seriousness with which the government proposes the trafficking Bill," Irani told the stakeholders.

The National Consultation is being spearheaded by Nobel laureate and Bachchan Bachao Andolan's Kailash Satyarthi who, kicking off the meet, said the Bill was one of the "best pieces of legislation" on the issue in the world.

"For the first time, we are looking at trafficking in its entirety, as an organised crime. Which means that the Bill will now propose a comprehensive list of different forms of trafficking which are aggravated in nature and accordingly enhance punishment for the same," said the minister.

Irani flagged the issue of mandatory reporting of trafficking, which she said was one of the most important aspects of the Bill.

She also said that concerns and suggestions that came out of the National Consultation would be incorporated in the Bill.

Vedanta plea in SC to continue oxygen ops in TN

VEDANTA LTD on Friday approached the Supreme Court, urging it to continue the permission granted earlier for production of medical oxygen at its steel/copper smelting facility at Theodukudai in Tamil Nadu.

Senior Advocate Harish Salve mentioned the company's request before a bench of Justices DY Chandrachud and M R Shah. Salve pointed out that the permission granted by the court on April 27 was only till July 31 and requested it to extend the same.

The Tamil Nadu government, however, opposed the request. Senior Advocate Kapil Sibal appearing for it said the state has sufficient amount of oxygen now.

The bench then fixed August 6 to hear the matter.

Vedanta, whose main copper smelting plant was shut down over

pollution concerns, had approached the court in April seeking permission to manufacture medical oxygen to meet the shortfall of the same for Covid-19 patients.

Allowing it "to operate the oxygen plant as a standalone unit", the SC clarified that "the order is passed only in view of the national need for oxygen".

Vedanta, the court added, shall be allowed to enter and operate the copper smelting plant under the garb of the order.

Maoist couple surrenders before Maharashtra Police

Nagpur: A Maoist couple has surrendered before Gadchiroli police in Maharashtra. Officers said the two had a reward of Rs 8 lakh on their head.

A press release issued by Gadchiroli SP Anil Goyal said, "Vinod alias Maniram Narasu Boga, 32, and wife Kavita alias Sato Harishgiri Kowachi, 33, surrendered before the police."

As per the release, Vinod was wanted in 13 cases of murder, 21 encounter cases, one arson case and five other serious crimes, while Kavita was named in six encounter cases, one arson case and three other crimes. ENS

Allopathy remarks: Ramdev gets a week to reply to doctors' lawsuit

New Delhi: The Delhi High Court Friday gave yoga guru Ramdev a week to reply to an application by doctors' associations for instituting a lawsuit against him for his statements on allopathy during the pandemic.

The lawsuit falls under Section 91 of the Code of Civil Procedure that deals with "public nuisance or any other wrongful act affecting or likely to affect the public," it can be instituted only by an Advocate General or with leave from a court.

The Residents Doctors' Association of All India Institute of Medical Science, Rishikesh and other unions representing the medical profession have sought a permanent and mandatory injunction against his "malafide misinformation campaign" against allopathy. They have contended such "misinformation campaign" during the ongoing pandemic has the propensity to divert people from allopathic treatments. The case will be heard on August 10. ENS

TACKLING COVID

India reports most new cases in 3 weeks

INDIA REPORTED 44,230 new Covid-19 cases on Friday, the most in three weeks, the latest evidence of a worrying trend of rising cases.

India was battered by the Delta variant of the virus in April and May but the rate of spread of infections later eased off. It has again been rising, with higher numbers in seven of the past eight days.

The nationwide tally of infections has reached 31.57 million, according to health ministry data. Deaths rose by 555 overnight, taking the overall toll to 423,217.

Medical experts poled by Reuters in late June said a third wave of infections was likely to hit India by October, though it would be better controlled than the April-May outbreak. Health experts have called for faster vaccinations to stave off another big surge.

The government estimates that 67.6% of the 1.35 billion population already have antibodies against the coronavirus, with nearly 38% of the adult population of about 94.4 million people having received at least one vaccine dose.

The disease's estimated reproduction rate, or R value, has inched up in the past week. It hit 1 on July 24 — meaning

CII, Serum to take vaccines to small towns, rural areas

THE CONFEDERATION OF Indian Industry (CII) has entered into an agreement with vaccine maker Serum Institute of India (SII) to take Covid-19 vaccines to small towns and rural areas. SII CEO Adar Poonawalla said the company is manufacturing vaccines at scale and the supply of Covishield would be available for distribution. It was essential for all stakeholders to work together to carry out the inoculations and take the vaccines to the hinterland, Poonawalla said. The partnership with CII is expected to close gaps and widen vaccination coverage. CII president TV Narendran said the country's post-pandemic growth depends on the pace at which the eligible population is vaccinated. CII will look to com-

plement and supplement the government's efforts, he said.

The CII partnership with SII will catalyse industry participation to reach out to communities at large. CII will connect the community, hospitals and corporates to fast-track vaccination Narendran said.

The confederation had also collated vaccine requirements of its members and administered 3.4 million single doses through 430 camps. CII is now mapping the vaccination needs of states and is setting up camps along with its members in Tier 2/3 cities and rural areas. — **FE BUREAU**

A STUDY COMBINING the first component of the Sputnik V vaccine and the AstraZeneca-Oxford University vaccine, conducted by the Russia Direct Investment Fund (RDIF), has found that the combination does not lead to adverse outcomes, RDIF said on Monday.

Initial data from the interim analysis on the immunogenicity of the combined use of the AstraZeneca and Sputnik V vaccines has demonstrated a "high safety profile" and "no serious adverse events or cases of coronavirus after vaccination", RDIF said.

This is the first study in the world that combined two vaccine doses. The initial data on the immunogenicity of the combined use of the two vaccines will be published in August.

MSMEs need most policy attention, says Niti Aayog VC

THE MSME SECTOR needs most policy attention, and the government will continue to do whatever is required to promote the sector, Niti Aayog vice-chairman Rajiv Kumar said on Friday.

Speaking at a virtual event organised by the Institute for Studies in Industrial Development, Kumar said the government and the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) have announced several measures to help the micro, small and medium enterprise (MSME) sector.

"The MSME sector needs most policy attention of all stakeholders... A lot has been written about the MSME sector but some of the challenges of the sector remained unmet till recently," he said.

Kumar said MSME earnings have been hit by 50%, and one out of three such firms suffered revenue and profit decline during the pandemic. "We will continue to do whatever is required to promote the MSME sector."

Listing out measures announced by the government to help the sector, he said that under the Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECLGS), ₹2.73 lakh crore has been sanctioned. "Risk capital requirements for MSMEs are now become part of global supply chains. He said 49.8% of India's exports come from the MSME sector. Even today, 99% of the total 63 million MSMEs are 'micro' and just 1% entities are in the range of 'small' and 'medium' enterprises, he said.
