PROJECTS UNDERTAKEN DURING FY 2021-22

During the year 2021-22, IRCTC has undertaken numerous initiatives towards CSR & Sustainability activities in the field of healthcare, sanitation and school education. The company has mainly focused on the Health Care and Health & Nutrition, with special focus on COVID related measures including setting up makeshift hospitals and temporary COVID Care Facilities" as common theme as per the guidelines of DPE. Broad Details of the activities undertaken during FY 2021-22 are as under:

1. Proposal from Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation of India for providing Distribution of Aids & Appliances to the Divyangjans at Jammu:

Under the broad theme of Health & Nutrition, IRCTC provided financial assistance towards Artificial Limbs Manufacturing Corporation of India for providing Aids and Appliance to Divyangjans in Jammu at a total project cost of ₹ 25 lacs.



2. Provision of bottle Crusher Units over TVC Division for Pet IRCTC Bottle.

Under the broad theme of Environment sustainability, IRCTC provided financial assistance towards the provision of bottle Crusher Units (5Nos) over TVC Division at a total project cost of ₹ 3.72 Lakhs.
