

## PROJECTS UNDERTAKEN DURING FY 2019-20

During the year 2019-20, IRCTC has undertaken numerous initiatives towards CSR & Sustainability activities in the field of healthcare and school education. The company has also focused on the development of Aspirational Districts as per the guidelines of DPE. Broad Details of the activities undertaken during FY 2019-20 are as under:

**1. Provision of Healthcare Equipments for Aspirational District Dhalai, Tripura**

Under the broad theme of health care, IRCTC financially supported the provision of healthcare equipments and ambulances for Aspirational District Dhalai, Tripura, at a total project cost of ₹ 48.2 lacs.

**2. Infrastructural Development of Anganwadi Centres of Aspirational District Ranchi, Jharkhand**

IRCTC financially assisted the provision of examination tables and three fold screens for various Anganwadi Centres of Aspirational District Ranchi, Jharkhand, at a total project cost of ₹ 27.5 lacs.



**3. Construction of Toilet Facilities in Girls Govt. Schools of Aspirational District Gajapati, Odisha**

Under the broad theme of education and sanitation, IRCTC provided financial assistance towards the provision of toilet facilities in 28 number of Government Schools of Gajapati District, Odisha, at a total project cost of ₹ 54.6 lacs.

**4. Improvement in the condition of drinking water in Aspirational District Siddharthnagar, Uttar Pradesh**

Under the broad theme of sanitation, IRCTC financially supported Pradeep Social Works to set up water systems to ensure improvement in the conditions of potable water in Aspirational District Siddharthnagar, Uttar Pradesh, at a total project cost of ₹ 10 lacs.


**5. Provision of delivery vehicles in Aspirational District Baran, Rajasthan in collaboration with Akshaya Patra Foundation**

Under the broad theme of nutrition and education, IRCTC financially supported Akshaya Patra Foundation to purchase 3 delivery vehicles to facilitate mid day meals in schools of Aspirational District Baran, Rajasthan, at a total project cost of ₹ 15 lacs.



**6. Provision of Thalassemia Wellness Centres collaboration with The Wishing Factory**

IRCTC financially supported The Wishing Factory to establish Thalassemia Wellness Centres cum Pump Libraries in Aspirational Districts of Dahod and Jaisalmer for Thalassemia Major Patients and Blood cancer patients so as to provide free healthcare and blood transfusion services, thereby reducing the financial burden on patients coming from the deprived sections of the society. The total cost of the project was ₹ 32 lacs.



**7. Provision of a community library in Aspirational District Gumla, Jharkhand**

IRCTC financially supported The Asian Heritage Foundation to set up a Centre for learning and transmission/ Community Library in Aspirational District Gumla, Jharkhand, at a total project cost of ₹ 8.50 lacs.

**8. Provision of 'Mini Science Centre' in 02 Govt. schools of Aspirational District Chandel, Manipur**

Under the broad of education, IRCTC in collaboration with District Collector Chandel financially supported the provision of 'Mini Science Centres' in 02 Govt. schools of Aspirational District Chandel, Manipur through Stem Learning Pvt. Limited at a total project cost of ₹ 10 lacs. The development objective of the project is to ignite scientific interest in children with the aim to alleviate their positive curiosity, creativity, scientific applicability and innovation.



**9. Development work under CSR activity at Kakole Village**

In FY 2017-18, development work under CSR activity was undertaken at Kakole Village, near Rail Neer Plant Ambarnath, Maharashtra. ₹ 14.73 lac i.e. 50% of the total project cost to build a pipeline in Kokale Village was released in FY 2019-20.



**10. Infrastructure development of Sapna Shikshalya**

IRCTC financially supported NGO Sapna for infrastructure development (Doors, Windows, Electrical Fittings, Plaster and Paint along with Installation of one Smart Classroom) of Sapna Shikshalya, at a total project cost of ₹ 8.35 lacs.

### **11. Infrastructural Development of Innovation Model School, Hardoi in collaboration with All India Citizens Alliance for Progress and Development**

IRCTC financially supported All India Citizens Alliance for Progress and Development (AICAPD) with the construction of 08 Classrooms and 01 Hall at Innovation Model School, Hardoi at a total project cost of ₹ 5 lacs. The Innovation Model School, aims at imparting continuous education and life skills to children from the deprived and underprivileged communities.



### **12. Provision of a mini truck for Shri Somnath Gurukul Sanstha, Bhopal**

Under the broad theme of environment and sustainability, IRCTC financially supported Shri Somnath Gurukul Sanstha to organize Narmada Zone Water conservation, sanitation and environmental awareness drives through Publicity Awareness Program in rural areas on the banks of Narmada River. The financial support was provided towards the provision of a mini truck along with the ancillary instruments to organize the awareness drives through advertisement and broadcasting. The total cost of the project was ₹ 10 lacs.

### **13. Provision of modern cotton harvesting technology as a tool of preventive health measure in collaboration with Cotton Corporation of India Limited**

Under the broad theme of healthcare, IRCTC financially supported Cotton Corporation of India Limited to provide cotton farmers hand-held kapas-plucker machines in a phased manner in order to supplement agriculture, modernize processing and decrease agri-waste. In addition, the machines also prevent contamination in cotton at farm level with plant debris, produce better quality due to lesser trash and thereby increase the income by reducing harvest cost. The project was executed in Khammam District, Telangana at a total cost of ₹ 10 lacs.

**14. Provision of Computers at the School of Ramakrishna Mission at Kila Maidan**

IRCTC supported Ramakrishna Mission with the provision of 22 new computers for their Computer Laboratory in the School of Ramakrishna Mission at Kila Maidan, Indore and for their Smart Classes. The project aimed at inculcating education and life skills through innovation and technology to children from the deprived and underprivileged communities. The total financial implication of the project was ₹ 7.5 lacs.



**15. Procurement of Medical Equipments at Rotary Ambala Cancer Detection & Welfare Society**

Under the broad theme of healthcare, IRCTC financially supported Rotary Ambala Cancer Detection & Welfare Society for the procurement of Medical Equipment Support (Ventilators, Monitors & Defibrillators) for The New Intensive Care Unit at a total project cost of ₹ 16,91,200/-. The primary beneficiaries of the project were the patients who otherwise would not have been able to access such medical care because of financial limitations.



**16. Infrastructure development towards Sanjeevani.. Life beyond Cancer**

IRCTC financially supported Sanjeevani.. Life beyond Cancer to purchase a Multi-Purpose Vehicle (Maruti Ertiga CNG) for conducting awareness programs in Mumbai as part of their Project titled “CanChetna – Program designed for a #CancerFreeIndia” at a total project cost of ₹ 10 lacs.

**17. Procurement of Kabaddi Mattress and Computers with Peripherals for Satya Foundation**

In pursuit of “Healthy India” mission and to promote sports, IRCTC financially supported Satya Foundation to provide Kabaddi Mattresses and Computers with Peripherals, for better practice and performance of Kabaddi Players of Baghpat, Uttar Pradesh. The total cost of the project was ₹ 5 lacs.

**18. Provision of “pick-up and drop facility” for children with special needs in collaboration with Param Shakti Peeth**

IRCTC financially supported Param Shakti Peeth to purchase a 26-seater school bus in order to facilitate “pick-up and drop facility” for children with special needs coming from low income groups. The total cost of the project was ₹ 15 lacs.

**19. Provision of Nutritional and Recreational Support in collaboration with Railway Children India**

Under the broad theme of nutrition and healthcare, IRCTC financially supported Railway Children India to provide nutritional and recreational support to vulnerable children protected at Ghaziabad Railway Station. The project aims to provide nutritious diet (4 meals a day) and proper sanitation along with regular health check up and counseling at a total cost of ₹ 8.94 lacs. ₹ 4.47 lacs was released in FY 2019-20.



**20. Equipment support for isolation ward for COVID-19 treatment in collaboration with Rotary Ambala Cancer and General Hospital**

Under the broad theme of healthcare, IRCTC financially supported Rotary Ambala Cancer and General Hospital for the procurement of Medical Equipment Support (3 monitors) for their isolation ward for COVID19 treatment, at a total project cost of ₹ 10,02,400/-.

**21. Allotment of 33% of Total CSR funds towards Swachh Bharat Activities**

As per the Department of Public Enterprise (DPE) guidelines dated 1<sup>st</sup> August 2016 regarding “Allocation of CSR funds by CPSE for Swachh Bharat Activities” whereby it has been advised to spend 33% of CSR funds by CPSEs towards sanitation as covered in item (i) of Schedule VII of companies Act, including contribution to “Swachh Bharat Kosh” set up by the Central Government. IRCTC allotted 33% of the total CSR funds towards “Swachh Bharat Kosh” for various Swachh Bharat Activities of the Government of India i.e. IRCTC contributed ₹ 2,53,11,000/- to “Swachh Bharat Kosh” set up by the Central Government.

**22. Food distribution by IRCTC Base Kitchen in the context of COVID-19**

With the unfortunate and sudden outbreak of COVID-19, Base Kitchens of IRCTC distributed food to the socially and economically disadvantaged sections of the society at a total cost of ₹ 41,09,314/-.

**23. Financial Support towards PM CARES Fund for assistance towards COVID-19**

Due to the outbreak of COVID-19, IRCTC also contributed ₹ 1.5 crore towards Prime Minister’s Citizen Assistance and Relief in Emergency Situations Fund’ (PM CARES Fund) for assistance to cater to the emergency needs to fight Corona Virus.
