annually to 2,01,000 tonne in the month. ATF sales were, however, 1,00,000 tonne more than May, with the opening of the domestic aviation sector with 33% capacity.

Muted consumption of petroleum products is discouraging for the Union government, which has sharply increased auto fuel taxes by ₹10/litre on petrol and ₹13/litre on diesel in early May. To shore of more revenue, a host of states have also increased their value added taxes on auto fuels. State-run oil marketing companies (OMCs) would also welcome higher sales as their fuel marketing margins are improving with diesel prices touching new records every day.

Liquefied petroleum gas was the only product which continued registering growth, rising 16.6% annually in June. next five months under the PM Garib Kalyan Ann Yojana (PMGKAY). The PMGKAY was announced in March by finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman after the first announcement of lockdown. Prime minister Narendra Modihas extended it till November. The Centre provides 5 kg of rice or wheat per person and one kg of chana per family free of cost every month to all the 81 crore beneficiaries under the NFSA. This is over and above their regular entitlement through PDS.

While 28 states have distributed the entire April quota of pulses under the scheme, Madhya Pradesh (67%), Bihar (82%), Maharashtra (82%) and West Bengal (87%) still lag behind. The distribution of chana in these states are further lower in May and June. Not a single grain has been distributed in West

for an estimated 8 crore migrant workers under the Atmanir bhar Bharat scheme after completion two months due to lack of response from the states.

Only 2.13 crore migrant workers availed the benefit of free grains in May-June. As many as 12 states have distributed less than 1% food grains while 6 states said that they didn't have any beneficiary under this scheme. Only seven states and union territories, including Rajasthan, Haryana and Himachal Pradesh, have distributed 50% or more of the allocated grains to migrant workers.

The government has said that it has 1.30 lakh tonne of chana under the buffer stock, which will be replenished from the 28.19 lakh tonne of chana maintained by the agriculture ministry under the Price Support Scheme.

CBI books alleged arms dealer for corruption involving Korean co

PRESS TRUST OF INDIA New Delhi, July 1

THE CBI HAS booked purported arms dealer Sanjay Bhandari for allegedly receiving about \$50 lakh from Korean company Samsung Engineering to influence officials in granting a contract for a DFCU project of OPAL at Dahej in Gujarat, officials said Wednesday.

The probe agency has also named the then Senior Manager of Samsung Engineering Hong Namkoong, UK-based Foster Wheeler Energy Ltd and Bhandari's UAE-based company Santech International FZC besides unidentified offi-


cials of ONGC and its special vehicle ONGC Petro Additions (OPAL) for alleged corruption, they said. Bhandari who is being probed in a number of defence deals is believed to be in London, they said.

The CBI has alleged that Bhandari as Director of Santech International entered into a criminal conspiracy with SECL by charging a consultancy fee of \$49.99 lakh from it, in violation of the integrity clause in the contract agreement between the Korean major and OPAL, they alleged.

The alleged consultancy fee was received in overseas accounts of Santech Interna-

tional, they said.

The agency has alleged that the consultancy charges were understood to be bribes for public officials.

the country after a month or two months. According to that, our projections showed that by June 30, there would be around 1 lakh cases in Delhi, out of which 60,000 would be active cases and around 15,000 beds will be needed in the hospitals," he said.

The city saw 87,360 cases till June 30. Of these, 26,270 were active cases. On Wednesday, the city saw 2,442 cases, taking the total to 89,802. As per the government dashboard, of the 15,242 hospital beds at present, 9,444 are available. 61 deaths were reported on Wednesday.

"We have managed to control the situation somewhat. At pres-

ent, the number of those being hospitalised is also decreasing. Last week, about 6,200 people were admitted. This number has now fallen below 5,800. We also see that where the recovery rate was around 38% last month, it has now risen to 67%... Where on June 23 there were 3,950 new cases, this number was around 2,200 on Tuesday. Positivity rate has fallen from 31% to around 13% now. The number of deaths per day has halved as compared to that on some days. While there is a decrease in these parameters, these numbers could rise again. We cannot be complacent. This virus is unpredictable," he said.

Sisodia orders audit into accounts of Delhi Univ college

NEW DELHI, JULY 1

DEPUTY CM Manish Sisodia Wednesday asked the Directorate of Higher Education to audit accounts of Delhi-government funded Bhagini Nivedita College (BNC) for the last two years, after he received complaints of financial irregularities against the principal.

"These complaints have come from different stakeholders like students, parents, teachers, etc. These allege financial irregularities in tendering processes, hiring of a car for the principal, buying of unnecessary items not needed in an educational institution, etc." Sisodia wrote to the Secretary Higher Education. "Directorate of Higher Education should immediately get the accounts of the last two years audited, preferably by a CAG empanelled auditor."

Manisha Saxena, Secretary Higher Education, said she had not yet received the letter, but added that the department had asked 12 colleges funded by Delhi government for salary bills and recruitment details earlier.

When contacted, BNC principal Charu Sharma said, "I'm shocked to hear this. I didn't know about it. I only took over as principal in April last year. Since the last one year, we have seen an in-

crease in academic seminars an student activities. The colleg should be known for that rather than all this."

BNC governing body chair man Pavan Sharma claimed h had also received complaint against the principal but did no divulge details. Asked if the G took a call to probe the complaints, Sharma said the las meeting on June 9 ended in walkout by some members, so the issue was not brought up.

This is not the first time the principal of BNC has faced allegations of financial and administrative irregularities.

Former principal Purbi Saikia had faced allegations of irregularities in faculty appointment, harassment of staff, misuse of staff car, bribery, following which the College GB had suspended ber.

It is clear to us that the SHO, Police Station, Sonia Vihar. and the IO concerned were absolutely indifferent to the complaint made by the petitioner since they did not even register a case on receipt of the petitioner's complaint on 12.06.2020... The FIR was registered only on 20.06.2020 - after the advance copy of the writ petition was circulated by the petitioner to the respondents. There is no explanation as to why there was a delay of eight days in the matter of registration of the FIR and in the matter of conduct of investigation."

The HC ordered that the IO to whom the case will be assigned

shall have the internal examination of the victim conducted without any delay.

"Though the petitioner's missing daughter has been located and returned to her parents, we are of the view that the investigation cannot be allowed to remain in the hands of the officers at Police Station Sonia Vihar. Accordingly, we transfer the investigation in this case to the Crime Branch forthwith," the court said.

The court has also directed the Commissioner of Police to grant audience to the petitioner and his counsel, so they shall disclose the manner in which police allegedly misused its authority.

The court directed the petitioner and his counsel to "produce all the documents/bills to substantiate their claim that they expended amounts for the travel, lodging and boarding of the police party at Jaipur and Kolkata. The Commissioner of Police shall examine all the material, including by calling upon the SHO, PS Sonia Vihar, to produce proof of expenditure incurred by the Police Department for the said visits, and on that basis, if a case is made out of misuse of authority, take appropriate action against the IO/SHO and all others concerned.
