The company obtained Certificate of Commencement of Business on 2nd December 999. The authorised share capital of the company is Rs. 50 crores and paid up share capital Rs. 20 crores, fully subscribed by Ministry of Railways, Government of India. The full-fledged inctioning of the Corporation started on 1st August 2001, after setting up of the functional

Total Revenue in Departmental catering was Rs. 241.15 crore in FY 2012-13 as compared s. 197.64 crore in FY 2011-12. The Non Railway Catering (NRC) units contributed Rs. 4 crore to the total revenue of Departmental catering business in FY 2012-13 as compared 10.79 crore in 2011-12. The increase in NRC revenue is mainly due to opening of new Units, operation of Food Factory, Noida etc. Licensee catering business generated an ne of Rs. 21.44 crore in the year 2012-13 as compared to Rs. 30.38 crore in the year
